

- Allow your child to have some input in family rules.

12-18 years

- · Talk with your teen not at him
- Show respect for your teen's opinions.
- Find opportunities such as car rides and television commercials to talk with your teen.
- Respect your teen's privacy and keep their confidences.
- Showing that you trust your teen will in turn encourage them to confide in you.
- Be yourself a teen is old enough to respect you as an individual.
