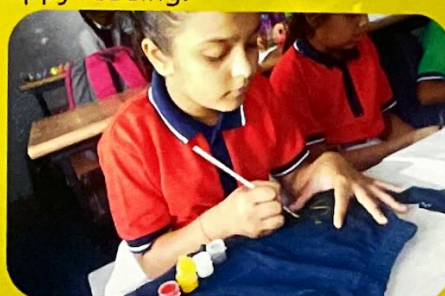
The exhilarating flashback of the inception of the school, its history and the events and achievements along with your same support will multiply our indefatigable efforts to brighten the future of our kids.

Ans. The Major positive aspects of becoming an RJ are that you become famous, punctual in life and contribute in the development of society.

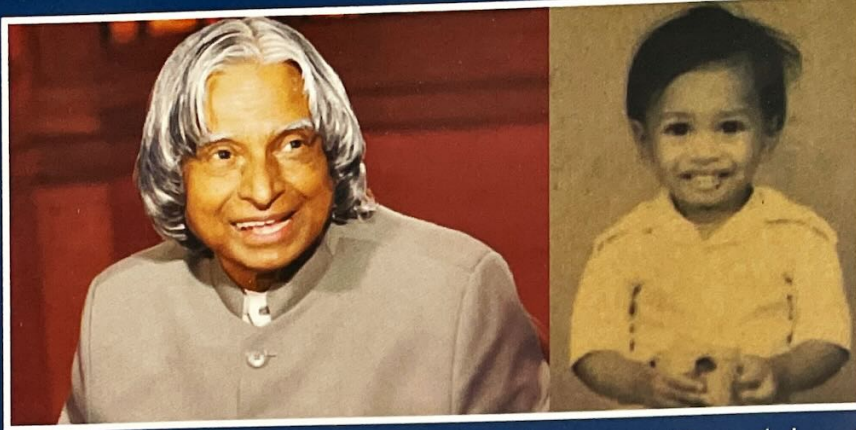
Q. How are RJ's able to talk flawlessly...without any hitches?

DR. APJ ABDUL KALAM

In the year 1947, the Second World War was just over and India awaited her freedom eagerly and the air was filled with the sound of indistinct buzz of the radio. Gandhiji declared, "Indians will build their own India". The whole country was filled with an unmatched optimism. That was the time when Dr. Kalam secretly wished for a chance to do something for his country. For this he knew that he needed to study hard and this was not possible without going to the school.

Since he was from a poor family he did not dare to ask his parents as they wouldn't be able to afford it. But, after few days Dr. Kalam was admitted to The Schwartz School in Ramanathapuram, a bustling town across the sea from Rameshwaram.

One day, as he was in hurry, he stepped into the wrong class, where his math teacher was taking class, he glared at Dr. Abdul through his glasses and said, "What are you doing in this school, if you can't even find your way to the right class? You should just go to the village where you came from". He then caught him by the scruff of his neck and caned him in front of the whole class. From that day on, Dr. Kalam made up his mind not only to be a good student but to be the best. He studied night and day and finally scored full marks in his Semester Exam. He was thrilled! The math teacher who had scolded him earlier said to others, "Whoever I punish becomes a great man!". The math teacher recounted what had happened. He pointed to Dr. Kalam and added, "Mark my words this boy is going to bring glory to his school and teachers". This praise made up for the earlier humiliation.

Dr. Kalam's family also rejoiced, and finally he felt that he had done something, but this was not the end and later he became one of the most loved president of our country, popularly known as 'The People's President.'

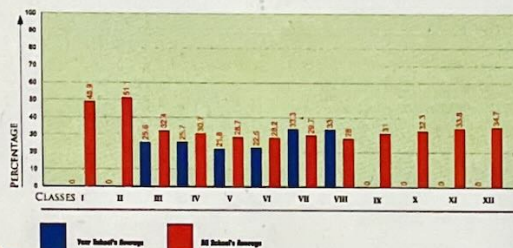

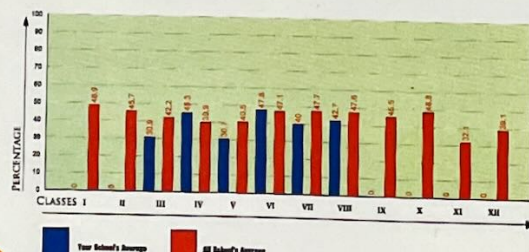

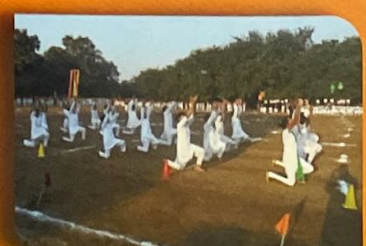
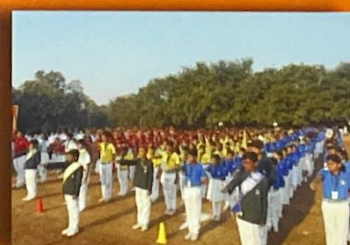
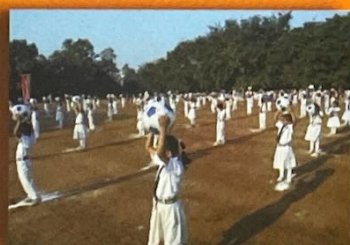
"WINNERS NEVER QUIT AND QUITTERS NEVER WIN"

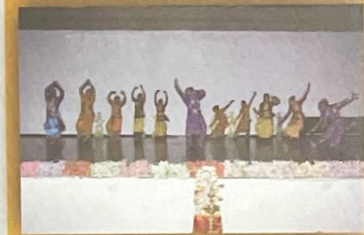

UNSUNG HEROES OF INDIA

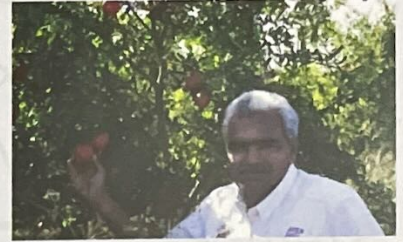


SHEKHAR NAIK:

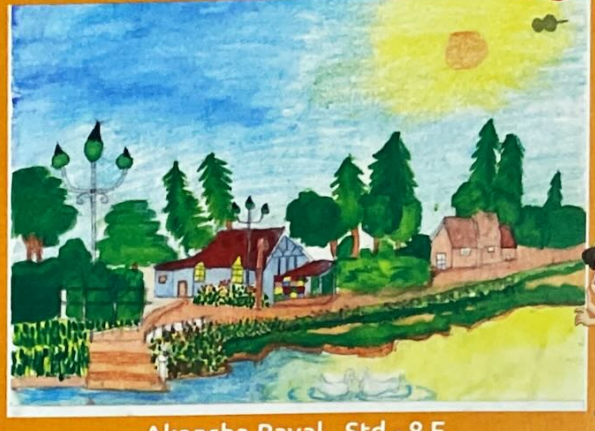
